- The committee reviewed the previous Strategic Plan and made updates for the new strategic plan.

Updates

Mr. Kristian reported the following:

- Seabrook Drive paving has been completed. Reflectors are still needed.
- Oyster Reef Drive is in the process of being paved.
- The Deerfield Drainage project will be underway soon.
- The pool is open and running smoothly.

- Kids Kamp is going well.
- The July 4 – HHP Day celebration went well with the safety modifications put in place.
- The first Deas-Guyz concert was on Thursday, July 9. It started to rain about an hour and a half in and they had to close down early. The next Deas-Guyz concert is scheduled for July 21.
- Hurricane season is here.
- Crime is low on the Plantation.
- A sub-committee has been formed under the Board of Directors to discuss and explore a name change for Hilton Head Plantation.
- The Short-Term Rental lawsuit has reached a settlement. More information will become available next month.
