- 1) Approval of the Minutes The Committee approved the May 9, 2023 minutes as submitted.
- 2) Introductions The committee briefly introduced themselves with new member Daniel Clare in attendance Ed Schottland, Board President, thanked the committee members for their service.
- 3) May 2023 Financial Report Mr. Lindstrom reviewed the May 2023 Financials, the current fund balances, assessments outstanding and the Capital Transfer Revenue. Revenue continues to track well above budget through five months with Gate revenue benefiting from the increased daily pass rate. Expenses are slightly under budget through five months with a few invoices still outstanding. Capital Transfer Revenue is off from 2022 levels but will get a surge from sales at The Charles over the next few months.
- 4) 2024 Budget Guidelines Mr. Kristian reviewed the Proposed 2024 Budget Guidelines that were submitted to the Executive Committee at their May meeting. He highlighted some of the significant points and the current market issues as well as what some other communities are proposing for 2024. There was some discussion on the labor market and how staff is managing current staffing needs. After discussion:

Mr. Clare made a motion to recommend the Board consider adopting the 2024 Budget Guidelines. Mr. Lambdin seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

- 5) General Manager Community Update Mr. Kristian updated the committee on the progress of several projects on the Plantation and in the community including the Dolphin Head Renovation status, the 278 bridge project status and the status of the submitted application for long-term permitting for Pine Island renourishment.
- 6) New Business Mr. Lindstrom noted that the applicable 2024 Interest Survey questions would be sent to the committee for review at a future meeting.

- 7) Next Meeting Next meeting will be July 20th.
